



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG.22 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Worcestershire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1 made by A.J. Phipps and Mrs G.E.M. Phipps and noted in the Register on 9 October 1968.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Worcester on 12 November 1974.

The hearing was attended by Mr H.A. Newell of Messrs Byrch Cox & Sons solicitors of Evesham on behalf of the Bretforton Parish Council by Mr Gareth Evans counsel instructed by Messrs Smith and Roberts of Evesham.

In the course of the hearing the parties reached an agreement and provided me with a copy of the agreed terms signed by Mr Newell and Mr Evans one of those terms being that I should confirm the disputed registration.

For this reason I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
