



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Tretire Common,
Tretire, South Herefordshire District,
Hereford and Worcester County

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 174 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hereford and Worcester (formerly herefordshire) County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 309 made by Hon James Campbell and noted in the Register on 28 September 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Hereford on 11 February 1981. At the hearing Mr Barry James West and Mrs Jennifer Mary West both of Tretire Mill as successors in title of Hon James Campbell attended in person, and Mr Ierin Evans and Mrs Rosemary Joy Evans of Tretire House Farm as successors in title of Mr Percy George Williams (now deceased) on whose application the registrations were made, also attended in person.

The grounds of the Objection are: "The part of OS no. 168 included on the provisional registration belongs to me and has never been common land. Plan attached overleaf, section outlined in red".

Mrs Evans said that she is the daughter of Mr Williams. Those present at the hearing were agreed that I should confirm the registrations with the modification hereinafter mentioned.

Accordingly I confirm that the Land Section registration with the modification that there be removed from the Register the part OS plot no. 168 outlined and coloured red on the plan attached to the said Objection, and I confirm the Rights Section registration without any modification save that which is consequential on the removal of the said part of OS plot no. 168 from the Land Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, with 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
