



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Bury Green, Little  
Hadham, Hertfordshire (No. 3)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 81 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hertfordshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 121 made by the Marquis of Salisbury and noted in the Register on 22 June 1972 and the conflicting registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 321 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hertford on 27 October 1982. The hearing was attended by Mrs A H Fardell, the Clerk of the Little Hadham Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

At a meeting of the Parish Council held on 4 October 1982 it was unanimously agreed to "withdraw" the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
