



In the Matter of Croxley Green, Croxley,  
Hertfordshire (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 35 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hertfordshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 25 made by the former Rickmansworth Urban District Council and noted in the Register on 6 November 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at St Albans on 5 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr J E Hudson, solicitor, on behalf of the Commoners of Croxley Green, the applicants for the registration, Mr J G Foster, the applicant for the registrations at Entry Nos 6 and 7 in the Rights section of the Register Unit, and Mr and Mrs S J Cox, the successors in title of Dr R H Leach, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 8 in the Rights section, and by Mr A R Hignett, solicitor, on behalf of the Three Rivers District Council, the successor authority of the former Rickmansworth Urban District Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of any of the applicants for the registrations at Entry Nos 1 to 5 in the Rights section.

Mr Hignett stated that he was instructed not to pursue Objection No. 25 in so far as it related to the registrations at Entry Nos 6 and 7 in the Rights Section.

It being admitted that the land was subject to the rights of common registered at Entry Nos 6 and 7 in the Rights section, I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
