

In the Matter of Part of Martins Green, -Brickendon Liberty, Hertfordshire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 112 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Hertfordshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 87 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Hertford on 26 October 1982. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

In the absence of any evidence that the land comprised in the Register Unit falls within the definition of "town or village green" in Section 22(1) of the Commons Registration Act 1965, I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
