

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 264/D/24

In the Matter of The Green, Bugthorpe, Humberside

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 60 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Humberside County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 18 made by Mr E C Bonsfield and Mr J D Spofforth and noted in the Register on 7 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Beverley on 1 April 1980. The hearing was attended by Mrs Birkinshaw, Solicitor, on behalf of the Humberside County Council, the successor authority of the former East Riding of Yorkshire County Council, which made the registration without application, and by Mr J W Buckley, Solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors.

The Director of Administration of the Humberside County Council informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by a letter dated 20 March 1980 that the County Council would not oppose the Objection, no evidence in support of the registration being available.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
