



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 264/D/23

In the Matter of The Village Green, SKipsea
Brough, Humberside

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of register unit No.CL.52 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Humberside County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 21 made by Mr and Mrs R A Bishop and noted in the Register on 18 May 1975.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Beverley on 15 January 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr P R Jennings, Solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors. There was no appearance on behalf of the SKipsea Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

There being no evidence to support the registration, I refuse to confirm it.

Since the objectors have incurred costs which could have been avoided if the Parish Council had given previous notice of its intention not to support the registration at the hearing, I shall order the Parish Council to pay the Objectors' costs of the hearing on County Court Scale 2.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
