



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the land section of Register Unit No. VG 91 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Kent County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 209 made by Kent County Council and noted in the Register on 31 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Maidstone on 6 February 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr J Carley the Chairman of Meopham Parish Council, on whose application the registration was made, there were no other appearances. Mr Carley asked for the registration to be confirmed and a written request by the Kent County Council for such information was available at the hearing.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
