In the Matter of Inglewhite Green, Goosnargh,  
Lancashire (No. 1)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. VG 9 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Lancashire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 209 made by Mr H Metcalf and others and noted in the Register on 26 October 1971 and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Preston on 30 January 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr E C Dickson, solicitor, on behalf of Mr and Mrs A E Dickson, the applicants for the registration, and by Mr M J Belderbos, solicitor, on behalf of the Objectors and on behalf of Mrs A Hopkinson (née Grimbaldston), the applicant for the conflicting registration.

Mr Dickson informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.


