COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 220/D/318

In the Matter of Rimington Moor, Rimington, Lancashire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 12 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.239 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 629 made by Mr N Lund and noted in the Register on 22 February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 29 June 1984. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. There were, however, sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners before the hearing copies of letters between Mr S F Moyle, the applicant for the registration, and the land agent acting for the Objector, from which it appears that the parties are agreed that the right the subject of the registration does not exist.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
