In the Matter of Salt Marshes, Bolton-le-Sands and Slyne-with-Hest, Lancashire (NO.1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 43 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 49 made by Mr G C Harries and Mr R G Swainson and noted in the Register on 4 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Lancaster on 1 March 1973 and 17 July 1984. The hearing in 1984 was attended by Mr R M N Gillibrant, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr A D Halhead, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr Le Poidevin, of counsel, on behalf of the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, the successor in title of the Objectors.

Mr Gillibrant and Mr N Le Poidevin informed me that their clients had agreed that I should confirm the registration with the following modifications, namely, the insertion of the words "with followers" after the word "sheep" and the deletion of the words in paragraphs 2 to 5, and this I accordingly do.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law may</u>, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
