COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 220/D/308

In the Matter of The Pinfold, Rawtenstall, Lancashire

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL.282 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lancashire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 409 made by the former Lancashire County Council and noted in the Register on 21 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Blackburn on 19 June 1984. The hearing was attended by Mrs S N Cunliffe on behalf of the Lancashire County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr W F Lloyd, the applicant for the registration, but in a letter dated 1 June 1984 Mr Lloyd informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners that he was instructed by the Chairman of the East Lancashire Commons Association to withdraw the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
