## In the Matter of Land near to the Church, Thorpe Langton, Leicestershire.

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land near to the Church, Thorpe Langton, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.C.L.59 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Leicestershire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Leicester on 11th October 1973.

At the hearing Mr. G.C. Greenwood, the Chairman of the Thorpe Langton Parish Meeting, told me that there was a garage on the land in question, but that he did not know to whom it belonged.

In the absence of any evidence as to the ownership I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
