

In the Matter of Holy Trinity Bridge, Crowland, Lincolnshire (No 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No VG 31 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former Holland County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 259 made by the former County Council and noted in the Register on 26 November 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Spalding on 19 April 1978. The hearing was attended by Dr D G Teall, as successor in title of Mrs A M Teall, the applicant for the registration, and Mr A G Dyer, Senior Assistant Solicitor of the Lincolnshire County Council.

Having in <u>In the Matter of Holy Trinity Bridge</u>, <u>Crowland (No 1)</u>, (1977) Ref. No 22/D/53 refused to confirm the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit, I refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
