



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Land on the East Side of the Road
from Queen's Bank to Postland Station,
Crowland,
Lincolnshire (No. 1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 54 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Holland County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 100 made by the Duke of Portland and noted in the Register on 30th September 1970 and by Objection No. 300 made by Mr A H C. Duveen and Mr A. B. V. Hughes and noted in the Register on 1st August 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly confirm the registration.
