



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 222/D/8

In the Matter of Stamford Freemen's Common
Stamford Lincolnshire (NO.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.3 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Lincolnshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.11 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Grantham on 23 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr A Scholes, the Chairman of the Freemen of the Borough of Stamford, the applicants for the registration. There was no appearance on behalf of the successor authority of the former Stamford Corporation, the applicant for the conflicting registration.

Since for the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Stamford Freemen's Common Stamford (NO.1) (1981), Ref.No. 222/D/7 I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.3, it follows that I must refuse to confirm the registration, the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
