



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 222/D/12

In the Matter of The Meadows (part)  
Stamford, Lincolnshire (NO.2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.VC.11 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Lincolnshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.CL.3 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Grantham on 24 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr A Scholes, the Chairman of the Trustees of the Charity known as the Stamford Freeman's Allotment, the applicants for both the registration and the conflicting registration.

The greater part of the land the subject of the registrations was allotted and awarded to the Trustees by the award made on 4 July 1872 by virtue of S.4 of the Stamford Inclosure Act 1871 (34 Vict., cxxxiv) and the remainder was acquired by virtue of an order of exchange dated 1 March 1933 and made by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries.

For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Stamford Freeman's Common Stamford (NO.1) (1981) ref. No. 222/D/7, I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.3. I therefore confirm the registration the subject of this dispute.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
