## DECISION

his reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as lownall Green, St. Helens, being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.51 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Rerseyside County Council of which no person is registered under section of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to e the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have nformation as to its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the wnership of the land at Chester on 20 November 1984.

here was no appearance at the hearing.

n the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the wner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection nder section 9 of the Act of 1965.

am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous n point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the ecision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the igh Court.
