



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Blakeney Carnser, Blakeney  
N. Norfolk D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.271 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 259B made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 22 February 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 11 January 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr P R Fitzgerald of Messrs. Walters Vandercom and Hart on behalf of The National Trust and Mr Curtis of Messrs. Butcher Andrews and Savory on behalf of Blakeney Parish Council.

The land in question was conveyed to The National Trust by a conveyance dated 1st August 1912 and by the Enclosure Award made in 1824 for the parishes of Blakeney, Wiveton and Glandford was allotted to Lord Calthorpe. The land is not now and has not since 1824 been waste of a manor and since there are no Entries in the Rights Section of the Register it is not common land as defined by the Act of 1965.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
