



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.25/D/167

In the Matter of Hardwick Narrows,  
West Winch and North Runcton, Norfolk (No.2).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entries Nos.1 to 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.310 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.91B made by Mr.F.H.Fuller, Clerk to the West Winch Parish Council, and noted in the Register on 4th August 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 26th June 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr.S.A.Mortimore, of counsel, on behalf of Mr.F.W.Fryatt, the applicant for the registration of rights of common over the land comprised in the Register Unit, and by Mr.Fuller.

The land comprised in the Register Unit consists of two separate areas, namely a long narrow strip to the north (Ordnance Survey No.236) and a rectangular piece to the south (Ordnance Survey No.16). Mr.Fuller's objection relates only to the latter.

For the reasons given in my decision in respect of the Land Section of the Register Unit (No.25/D/166) I have decided to exclude O.S.No.16 from the Register Unit. It therefore only remains for me formally to dispose of this dispute by confirming the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
