

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No 225/D/74

In the Matter of Marsh Land to the East of Beach Road,
Cley, Norfolk.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No VG 106 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 340B made by the Norfolk Naturalists Trust and noted in the Register on 25 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 15 March 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J H Howard, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector. There was no appearance on behalf of the Cley Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, but in a letter sent to the Clerk to the Commons Commissioners before the hearing the Clerk to the Council stated that the Council had agreed to "withdraw" the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
