

In the Matter of The Clay Pit, Crabbe. Road, Wighton, Norfolk.

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No VG 100 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 80B made by the late Earl of Leicester and noted in the Register on 15 July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Norwich on 14 March 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr K G Seaman, the Chairman of the Wighton Parish Council, the applicant for the registration. Before the hearing Messrs Walters Vandercom and Hart, the solicitors for the Special Representatives of the late Lord Leicester, wrote to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners stating that they were instructed to "withdraw" the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
