

In the Matter of Various Pieces of Common Land, Denver, Norfolk (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos 1 to 4 (inclusive) in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 244 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Norfolk County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 383 B made by the Central Electricity Generating Board and noted in the Register on 11 May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at King's Lynn on 30 June 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr J C Sharpe, the Chairman of the Denver Parish Council. Since in the circumstances set out in my decision relating to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of this Register Unit (1977), Ref Nos. 25/D/208, 209 and 211 the land to which the Objection relates has been excluded from the Register Unit,

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
