



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 268/D/290-292

In the Matter of Conistone Moor and Bycliffe,
Conistone with Kilnsey, Craven D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and at Entries Nos. 1-8 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 186 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objections No. 601 made by the Executors of W D Roberts and No. 2381 made by Clement Blackburn Trustees noted respectively in the Register on 27 February 1971 and 8 September 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 8 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr M Gillibrand, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the Executors of W D Roberts, and by Mrs J Cooker, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Clement Blackburn Trustees.

I was informed that an agreement was in course of negotiation and at the request of the parties appearing adjourned the hearing. Agreement has now been reached and I have received a written application, signed by or on behalf of the applicants for registration in the Land Section and the Rights Section, *of their successors,* requesting that confirmation of the registration as Common Land be refused. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registrations in the Land Section and the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision of sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
