

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 268/D/335-336

In the Matter of Dallowgill Moor (part) Laverton, Skelding and Fountains Earth, Harrogate B

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration; at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 612 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 93 made by Mr G S Bostock and noted in the Register on 30 June 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Harrogate on 12 March 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R Wakefield of Counsel, appearing on behalf of Mr Bostock. The Entry in the Rights Section was made on the application of Mr J W Burrill, and it was in consequence of this application that the Entry in the Land Section was registered. Mr Burrill was not present or represented at the hearing.

In the absence of evidence to support the registrations, I refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
