



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 268/D/298-300

In the Matter of Giggleswick Common,
Craven D

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 5 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 114 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by Objections No. 145, 146 and 147 made respectively by W Bilsborough, N Sutcliffe and W S Walker and all noted in the Register on 4 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Skipton on 8 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr W Foster, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the applicants for registration of Entry No. 5, and by Mr R Bowker appearing on behalf of the Objectors.

Entry No. 5 is of a right to graze a number of animals at different periods of the year: the objections were all on the ground that the period does not correspond with other claimants. The parties had reached agreement that the Entry should be amended to a right to graze (a) 1 sheep and 6 followers from 1 April to 14 August (b) 2 sheep from 15 August to 31 October (c) 2 sheep from 1 December to 31 January: and accordingly I confirm the registration with this modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
