



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.268/D/263

In the Matter of Land beside Hilla Green Bridge,
Hackness, North Yorkshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. ¹⁸⁶ 186 in the Register of ~~Common Land~~ ^{Town or Village Green} maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.0331 made by Mr J.B.Slatcher and noted in the Register on 21st October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitby on 4th June 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr P.M.White, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector. There was no appearance on behalf of the Ramblers Association, the applicant for the registration.

There being no evidence in support of the registration, I refuse to confirm it.

Mr White applied for an order for costs. Since there had been no communication from the Applicant to the Objector indicating that there would be no appearance on behalf of the Applicant, I shall order the Applicant to pay the Objector's costs on County Court Scale 2.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
