



In the Matter of Part of the River Swale and Land
adjacent thereto, Brompton on Swale, North Yorkshire
(No 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 195 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire Council Council and is occasioned by Objection No 067 made by Tilling Construction Services Ltd and noted in the Register on 13 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 10 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr D H Ibbotson, the Chairman of the Brompton on Swale Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr R H Kellet, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

The land comprised in the Register Unit consists of three lengths of half the River Swale and the banks on the north side. The western-most two of these lengths are near to the village of Brompton on Swale and the other is some distance away to the east of Catterick Bridge.

Mr Kellet informed me that the Objector was interested only in the land to the east, which the Parish Council was content to have excluded from the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely, the exclusion of the land to the east of Catterick Bridge.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
