



In the Matter of Pieces of Land, Grinton,
North Yorkshire (No 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No VG 135 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 307 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Richmond on 11 May 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr E R D Johnson, solicitor, on behalf of the Grinton Parish Council, the applicant for both registrations.

The land comprised in the Register Unit includes the whole of the land the subject of the conflicting registration, a part of which is the subject of applications for entries in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 307. Mr Johnson informed me that the Parish Council did not wish to support the registration the subject of this reference in so far as it relates to the land referred to in the entries in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 307.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely, the exclusion of the land referred to in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 307.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
