



In the Matter of Scruton Village Green,
Scruton, North Yorkshire (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 2 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 032 made by Dr J T A George and noted in the Register on 2 October 1969.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Northallerton on 9 March 1977. The hearing was attended by Miss Z L Chilton, the applicant for the registration, who spoke through her brother, Mr J G H Chilton, by Mr Christopher Proctor, solicitor, on behalf of the Scruton Parish Council, whose application for the registration was noted under section 4(4) of the Commons Registration Act 1965, and by the Objector.

The Objection relates only to two tracks traversing the land comprised in the Register Unit, and both Miss Chilton and the Parish Council were agreeable to the exclusion of these tracks.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification:- namely the exclusion of the land shown coloured green on the plan attached to the Objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
