## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.380 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1156 made by Mr E Elcock and Objection No. 2068 made by Yorkshire River Authority, noted in the Register respectively on 7 June 1971 and 24 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at **\$e**lby on 9 July 1985. At the hearing Mr C F Eyre, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of Mr D A Riley, successor in title to Mr Elcock: Mr R Simpson, Solicitor, appeared on behalf of Yorkshire Water Authority: and Cawood Parish Council was represented by its Clerk, Mrs J Sykes.

The Parish Council was the applicant for registration and had since notified its decision to withdraw the registration: this was confirmed by Mrs Sykes.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous  $\underline{\text{in point of law}}$ , may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
