



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 268/D/323-324

In the Matter of The Village
Green and Beckside, Otterburn

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 402 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. ~~349~~³⁷⁴ made by Muriel Haggas and Objection No. 358 made by Arthur Caton and respectively noted in the Register on 14 May 1970 and 21 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 9 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr W Foster, Solicitor appearing on behalf of Richard Haggas (the successor to Muriel Haggas), and by Mr Caton in person.

The two Objections relate to different sections of the land comprised in the Register Unit. Mrs V E Fell, the applicant for registration, had written accepting the Objections: and accordingly I confirm the registration modified so as to exclude from the land the two sections shown on the plans attached to the Objections.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
