

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 45/D/62

In the Matter of Townerd Green, Kettlewell with Starbutton

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 463 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 908 made by D Halliday and noted in the Register on 27 May 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Skipton on 8 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Halliday in person, and by Mr J C Hall, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Kettlewell with Starbutton Parish Council, on whose application the registration was made. Mr Halliday's Objection was on the ground that the land was not common land and the Objection was withdrawn by him at the hearing and accordingly I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
