DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 44 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 23 made by Bass Ltd and noted in the Register on 13 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Selby on 12 May 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr C Brown of Messrs Drivers, Solicitors of York appearing for Riccall Parish Council and Mr I R Fowler of Messrs Denison, Suddards and co, Solicitors of York appearing for Bass Ltd. Mr Fowler informed me that his client withdrew the Objection.

For these reasons I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
