



In the Matter of Ugthorpe Moor, Ugthorpe,  
North Yorkshire (No. 3)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 137 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 04 made by Mrs H M Hill and noted in the Register on 2 December 1968, Objection No. 045 made by Mr J J Readman and noted in the Register on 10 February 1970, and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of in quiring into the dispute at Whitby on 27 May 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr T Etherton, of counsel, on behalf of the Marquis of Normandy, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1, and by Mr Ian Lamb, of counsel, on behalf of Mr T M Hill, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 2, and Mrs Hill. Mr Readman did not appear and was not represented.

I heard these disputes with the dispute relating to the registration at Entry No. 2 occasioned by the registration at Entry No. 1. After hearing the evidence adduced in support of the registration at Entry No. 2 I indicated that I was not satisfied that Mr Hill had made out his claim to be the owner of the land comprised in the Register Unit. Mr Lamb informed me that in that case Mr Hill no longer wished to object to the confirmation of the registration at Entry No. 1.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
