## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.49 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the North Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 18 made by G B Palmes and noted in the Register on 5 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Selby on 9 July 1985. The hearing was attended by Capt F W Shamler, a member of Naburn Parish Council, and by its Clerk Mr John Dykes.

The registration as village green was made on the application of the Parish Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Objector and I was told that he is now dead.

In the circumstances I shall confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous  $\underline{\text{in point of law}}$  may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
