

COLDIONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Mos 226/D/56 226/D/57

In the Matter of The Village Green at Lois Weedon, Weston and Weedon, South Northamptonshire District. Morthamotonshire

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. VG 47 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Northamptonshire County Council and are occasioned by these registrations being in conflict.

Both the registrations relate to all the land in this Register Unit, that at Entry No. 1 being of the ownership of All Souls College Oxford, and that at Entry No. 2 being of the ownership of Weston and Weedon Parish Council.

All Souls College, Weston and Weedon Lois Parish Council, Northamptonshire County Council and South Northamptonshire District Council have agreed that the confirmation of the registration at Entry No. 2 should be refused and confirmation of the registration of Bring No. 1 chould be given, and have sent to the Clark of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such agreement signed on their behalf.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Northampton on 7 February 1979. The hearing was attended by Mrs B J Richards of Lois Weedon Farm in person.

At the hearing I stated the affect of the said agreement, and Mrs Richards said that it is correct and that she had nothing else to say.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the said agreement, and I accordingly refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No. 2 (the Parish Caucit) and I confirm the registration at Entry No. 1 (All Souls College) without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in noint of 1 may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
