

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 227/U/8/8

In the Matter of Glanton Village Green, Glanton, Alnwick District, Northumberland

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Glanton Village Green, Glanton, Alnwick District being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG. 36 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Northumberland County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Alnwick on 21 June 1977. There was no appearance at the hearing.

After the hearing I inspected the land. It is a small piece of grass land attractively laid out with three rose beds situate in the middle of the Village at the beginning of the Whittingham Road. In the absence of any evidence as to ownership I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Northumberland County Council, as registration authority, to register Glanton Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
