



In the Matter of Barrow Hills at Harwell,
Everton

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of the land above mentioned being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.70 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Nottinghamshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Everton Parish Council claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Nottingham on 28 February 1985. Mr J Pennington (a member) appeared for the Parish Council and produced a copy of the Everton and Harwell Inclosure Award 1761 in which the land was allotted to the Townships of Everton and Harwell for repair of roads.

Harwell is now part of the Parish of Everton.

For these reasons I am satisfied that Everton Parish Council is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Nottinghamshire County Council, as registration authority, to register Everton Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8 (2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
