



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 228/D/10

In the Matter of land adjacent to the  
Allotment Gardens, Babbington, Strelley

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 75 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Nottinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 18 made by Elsie Mary Hawthorn and noted in the Register on 29 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Nottingham on 14 January 1981. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard other than Mr M Maher who appeared for the Registration Authority. Miss Hawthorn, the original objector informed the Commons Commissioners through her Solicitors, by letter dated 30 December 1980, that she was no longer concerned to support her objection and no other person appeared in support of it.

For these reasons I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
