In the Matter of land from Footpath and Verge to Midstream between Village Green and Sheepwash, Winthorpe.

## DECISION

his reference relates to the question of the ownership of the land bove mentioned being the lamd comprised in the Land Section of legister Unit No.CL.25 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Nottinghamshire County Council of which no person is required inder section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference Winthorpe ith Langford Parish Council claimed to be the freehold owner of he land in question and no other person claimed to have information s to its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of he ownership of the land at Nottingham on 31 October 1984.

r McKinnell appeared for Newark District Council and Mr M Shapley, member, appeared for the Parish Council.

received a copy of a letter written by the Clerk to the Parish council to the Newark District Council stating that a representative f the Parish Council would be present at the hearing and that the arish Council felt that the land being virtually under the control f the Parish Council since registration belonged to the village.

o other evidence was given.

n this evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of he land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under ection 9 of the Act of 1965.

am required by regulations 30 (1) of the Commons Regulations 1971 o explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneo n point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of he decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the ecision of the High Court.
