COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/670

In the Matter of a Tract of Land forming part of
Mynydd Eppyat Penbualt

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.71 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 156 made by the Trustees of the Glanusk Settlement and noted in the Register on 4 November 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 27 July 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr J Bengough of Messrs. Knight Frank and Rutley, Chartered Surveyors of Hereford representing the Objectors. The Applicants did not appear and were not represented. Mr Bengough said that the applicants had agreed to withdraw their claim to take water to which his clients had objected and on that footing the objection would be withdrawn.

For these reasons I confirm the registration subject to the deletion from column 4 of the whole of sub-paragraph (b).

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
