



In the Matter of a tract of land known as
Drygan Fawr, Abergwesyn

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 7, 8 and 9 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 42 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objections No. 636, 635 and 634 made by Birmingham Corporation and noted in the Register on 5 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 22 February 1984. The hearing was attended by Mrs R E Durkin, Solicitor appearing for the Welsh Water Authority, successor in title to Birmingham Corporation and Mr W Davies of Messrs Milwyn, Jenkins and Jenkins, Solicitors of Llanidloes appearing for Mr D E Evans, who informed me that the Objections were withdrawn on the Applicants agreeing that the rights were not exercisable over the land, shown coloured blue on the plan attached to each of the Objections.

For these reasons I confirm all the registrations with the following modification that in each case the rights are not exercisable over the land shown coloured blue on the relevant objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
