



In the Matter of a Tract of Land known as part
of Buckland Hill, Bwlch

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 2, 6 and 7 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 20 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 48, 315 and 348 made by the Chairman of the Duke of Beaufort's Brecon Estate Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 28 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 16 November 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr C C Boutcher in person and Mr G W Shellare, Chartered Surveyor for the Commoner's Association.

It was agreed that the three disputed registrations should be confirmed subject to the following modifications:-

Entry No. 2 limited to Estovers
Entry No. 6 limited to 70 sheep or stock equivalent
Entry No. 7 limited to 15 sheep or stock equivalent and Estovers.

For these reasons I confirm all the registrations with the modifications already mentioned.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
