

MONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/382-383

In the Matter of Bryn Wg, Darowen

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 2 and 3 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL 10 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Montgomeryshire County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registrations at the two Entries.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Welshpool on 3 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J I Williams, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of Sir Owen W Wynne the applicant for registration of Entry No. 2: and by Mr J H Parsons, Solicitor appearing on behalf of Mr W D Hughes the applicant for registration of Entry No. 3.

Entry No. 2 comprises a part of the land and includes an area at the southern end, this area being marked C on the register map. Entry No. 3 also relates to this area. It was agreed that this area should be excluded from Entry No. 2; accordingly I confirm the registration at that Entry modified so as to exclude the area, and confirm the registration at Entry No. 3 without modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
