

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 276/D/251

In the Matter of Craig-y-Ddinas, Penderyn, Brecknock BC

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 47 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Breconshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 232 made by Economic Forestry Wales td and noted in the Register on 8 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 12 July 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Dewi Wyn Thomas clerk to the Penderyn Community Council and Mr Mallows on behalf of the Forestry Commission the successor to Economic Forestry.

Mr Mallows stated that the land in question is of no use to the Commission which is content that the Community Council shall make the best possible use of the land, for the benefit of the community. In these circumstances Mr Wyn Thomas accepted that the interests of his Council might be best served by not imposing on the land the status of common land, which in my view it does not have, and was content that I should refuse to confirm the Registration.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Yourt.
