

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 276/D/54

In the Matter of Cwmgwyn and Medwalleth Common, Beguildy

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 22 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL. 20 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 623 made by Mr J L Mills and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at L landrindod Wells on 7 January 1976.

The Applicant did not appear.

The Objector was represented by Mr Gareth Morris, Solicitor of the firm of Dilwyn Jones & Co. The ground of the objection was that the Applicant had no rights over the Common.

In the absence of evidence I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
