



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 276/D/267 to 270

In the Matter of Hundred House Common,  
Llansaintffraed-in-Elvel, Radnor D

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DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in the Land Section, all the Entries in the Rights Section and Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 57 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Radnorshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos 20 and 21 both made by The Representative Body of the Church in Wales and both noted in the Register on 22 October 1969 and Objection No 325 made by the Glanusk Estate and noted in the Register on 26 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llandrindod Wells on 7 June 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr H J Cave on behalf of Powys County Council the Registration Authority. Objection Nos 20 and 21 relate to two small parcels of land. The parcel in the west has already been conceded and the Entry in the Land Section amended accordingly. Mr Cave informed me that the parcel on the east is now also conceded. No applicants for Rights appeared and I therefore confirm the Entry in the Land Section modified so as to exclude both the small parcels identified on the plan annexed to Objection Nos 20 and 21 and I confirm the Entry in the Ownership Section as applicable to the modified Entry in the Land Section. The Glanusk Estate withdrew its Objection No 10 in the Rights Section and I therefore confirm all the Entries in the Rights Section as applicable to the modified Entry in the Land Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
