

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 276/D/639-641

In the Matter of land being part of Eppynt
Common in the Parishes of Llangwynog, L
Llanddewir Cwm and Alltmawr

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1, 20 and 35 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 102 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Powys County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 489-491 made by Mr E T R Jones and noted in the Register on 15 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 14 March 1983. The hearing was attended by Mr Jones, the Objector, appearing on behalf of the Eppynt Commoners Association, of which is is the Secretary. Mr David Lloyd of Messrs H Vaughan and Co, Solicitors of Builth Wells appeared for Messrs Powell the applicants at Entry No. 20. Mr Jones informed me that the Association had agreed with the Rights Applicants that the Objections would be withdrawn and that I should be asked to confirm the three applications subject to the following modifications.

Entry No. 1

Delete '240 sheep to 7 sheep' and substitute '160 sheep plus lambs or 1 pony in place of 7 sheep to a maximum of 20 ponies'

Entry No. 20

Delete '465 sheep or 66 ponies' and substitute '201 sheep or equivalent in ponies, 7 sheep equalling 1 pony'

Entry No. 35

Add after 'equivalent' '7 sheep equalling 1 pony'.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations with the modifications already mentioned.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
