



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 276/D/303-306

In the Matter of land forming part of the
Black Mountains known as Fwddwg Ridge
Crucorney Fawr Monmouth D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entries No 12 and 29 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 45 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Breconshire County Council and is occasioned by Objections Nos 280 and 286 both made by The Duke of Beauforts Commoners Association and both noted in the Register on 25 August 1971 and objection No 599 made by the Black Mountain Graziers Association and noted in the Register on 10 November 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Brecon on 18 April 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr G W Shellard the Secretary of the Duke of Beauforts Commoners Association and Mr Stephens the former chairman of the Black Mountain Graziers Association.

There was produced a withdrawal ^{by} to the Representative Body of the Church in Wales, signed on its behalf by its agents Messrs Cooke & Arkwright, of its application under Entry No 12 and for this reason I refuse to confirm that Entry.

There was also produced a signed consent by Diana Smyth to the modification of her Entry No 29 (formerly 11) by excluding therefrom the claim to a Right of Estovers. With the agreement of Mr Shellard and Mr Stephens I confirm Entry No 29 modified as aforesaid.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
